WHY NOW?

CHALLENGE FORMAT

The fun kicks off on Thanksgiving (November 28th) with a host of extra-credit missions. Teams will earn early points by participating in community-based volunteer projects such as making holiday cards for veterans, packing healthy meals for local pantries, or donating gifts to families in need. Then on Sunday, December 8th, participants will convene in downtown Chicago under the twinkling holiday lights on Magnificent Mile for the main event.

Guests will sip warm holiday drinks and sample tasty treats at the InterContinental Hotel. Teams of 4-6 will race around downtown Chicago to see who can complete the most tasks that make others smile: caroling at Cloud Gate, giving "thank you" notes to city workers, staging scenes from the Nutcracker...the list goes on! Folks at home can follow the fun on social media with live updates from the field. We expect a sold-out event of 250+ participants and hundreds more tuning into our live feed of the event, so secure your sponsorship today!

HONEYCOMB VOLUNTEER PROFILE

In 2023, Honeycomb mobilized over **4,000 volunteers** in meaningful acts of service. Honeycomb families came from 88% of Chicago zip codes; in addition, 61 suburban zip codes were represented. 45% of Honeycomb volunteers identify as multi-racial or people of color. 60% of volunteers identify as female, 39% identify as male, and 1% non-binary. Our online volunteer resource *Honeycomb at Home* has been accessed by 2,500+ youth, parents, and educators from across the U.S.

17% of youth who participate in Honeycomb programs were in the 6-8 age group, with an additional 31% in the 9-11 age group. The number of teens ages 12-17 has grown in recent years as many children continue to grow their leadership with Honeycomb. Teens now represent 43% of youth participants.
